- 10 一家國際公司的顧問,李女士認為: "我們需要改變對考試的態度,公司不應該只看學生的考試成績。公司和企業現在更加重視的是員工願意不願意不斷地學習。" 二十年以前,學生只想着考試成績。他們認為如果上了好大學,以後他們的生活和工作就會更好,而且他們也不需要再學習了。但是隨着科學技術和社會的飛速發展,這種觀念早已過時了。

15 給中學生們的建議

來自西安的王校長指出,中學生正處於人生的重要階段,需要學會如何終身學習,為未來做好充分的準備。王校長提出以下一些建議: "首先,學生應該培養好的學習習慣,安排好自己的時間,這對終身學習非常重要。其次,中學生還應該在課外,多看書,多交朋友,培養更多的興趣愛好。另外,中學生20 還應該增加自己的社會經驗,找機會把學到的知識用到生活中,這樣能幫助學生提高社交能力和他們解決問題的能力。最後,學生應該保持對世界的好奇心。這樣,他們就會去尋找新的學習機會,讓自己成為對社會更有用的人,同時,好奇心還會讓學生們對生活更有熱情。"

總之,不管你是中學生,大學生,還是成年人,會終身學習的人能夠根據 25 社會變化和個人追求,提升自己的競爭力。現代社會永遠需要那些會思考,敢 於嘗試.不斷學習的人。
