Carnival World would like a design proposal for new outdoor interactive playground equipment for children.

The company has indicated that the proposal needs to allow two children to play at the same time, and have a range of sensory play features, including sound.



It will also need to be secured to the ground.

You can use one or more of the components shown on pages 24-26 within the assembly of the proposal.

Interview with co-ordinators

Play co-ordinators from Carnival World were asked the following questions. Their responses were collated and are shown below.

- Q1 What age group should the playground equipment be designed to suit? Children between 4 and 6 years old should be able to play with it.
- Q2 Are there any restrictions on the overall size of the playground equipment?
 - The equipment needs to fit inside the existing play parks. There is a maximum $2m \times 2m$ area at each location for the equipment.
- Q3 You said the design must include a range of sensory features including sound. What other sensory play features do you think will engage children?
 - There are different types of sensory play features that children of this age group enjoy sorting and moving objects, touching different textures, balancing items, moving objects, and playing with liquids. We would like the equipment to include sound and another two sensory features.
- Q4 Are there any other requirements for the playground equipment? The sound feature should be created using beater sticks, therefore two sets of these should be included. The equipment must also be easy for staff to maintain at the end of each day.
- Q5 How many will be required and what is the budget?

 We will require 10 products and our budget for each is £300.
