Choose **one** of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Society

You should write approximately 150–180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Employability

You spent two months working in a hotel in Spain/a Spanish speaking country. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- where exactly the hotel was **and** what it was like
- what you had to do every day as part of your duties
- what skills you learned
- how you got on with the people you worked with
- what you did on your days off
- how you think this experience will help you in the future.

You should write approximately 150–180 words.
